

**Message to Secondary Families who Selected In-Person Courses**

**Subject Line:** In-Person and Virtual Secondary Course Selections

*This e-mail is being sent to parents/guardians of students who have selected in-person courses for the 2021-22 school year*

Dear Students and Parents or Guardians,

We are writing to follow up with you regarding your decision to select in-person courses for the 2021-22 school year now that all secondary students have completed the course selection process through their home school.

Given the lower interest in virtual course selections across the District, we wanted to inform you that we are now moving forward with a centralized virtual model similar to this year with DDSB@Home Secondary. As a result, we are providing students the option to change their decision between in-person and virtual learning and that there will be a [few more optional courses available](#) in grades 11 and 12.

**If you think would now prefer to enroll in virtual courses**, we need you to please click the link below to inform us of your intention to switch to virtual learning.

If you want your child to remain in in-person learning for the 2021-22 school year, you do not need to click the link or do anything further at this time.

Once we confirm everyone's intention to be in virtual or in-person learning for the 2021-22 school year, we will be providing students enrolled in virtual learning the opportunity to revise their course selections. More information on how to do this will be shared with those who have selected virtual learning after April 20.

We would like to remind you that this is a permanent choice for the upcoming school year as we are limited in our ability to transfer students to/from virtual learning due to how courses are timetabled

based on student requests. We also require you to make this decision now in order to ensure that we can appropriately staff courses.
